

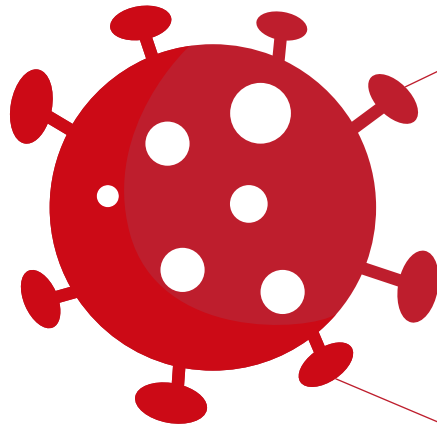

It reared its ugly head for the first time in Wuhan, China in December 2019 and has since then spread globally



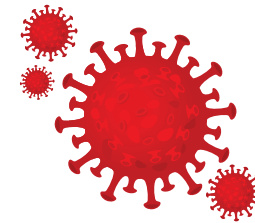
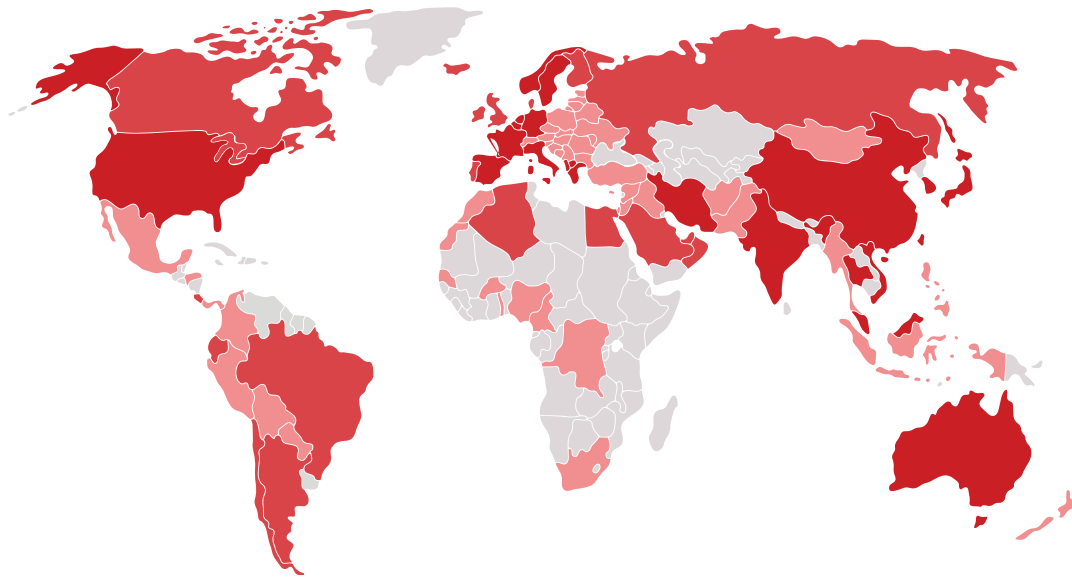

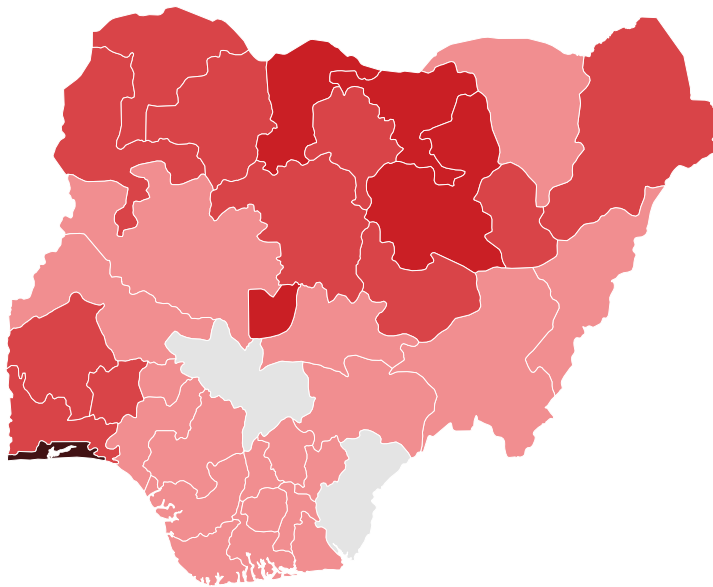

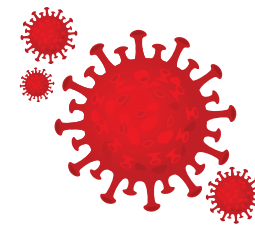
