


Coronavirus infectious disease is caused by the newly discovered virus labeled SARS-CoV-2 or COVID-19

It reared its ugly head for the first time in Wuhan, China in December 2019 and has since then spread globally


Persons infected with the disease experience respiratory illness

Largest number of cases and deaths are in Europe and America








Nigeria index case: 27 February

April 2020










PROACTIVE ACTION





- Awareness campaigns using TV, radio, print media, social media, and sensitization tours.
- © Created the Ondo State COVID-19 website as well as the emergency callcenter with toll free numbers 0800-COVID19
- Shut all schools and commenced educational programming for students on TV and radio

PROACTIVE ACTION (Contd.)



- Ban on religious, political and social gatherings
- Created the Ondo State COVID-I9 Response Fund Committee
- Created the Ondo State COVID-19 Palliatives Committee
- Closed inter-state borders

Approval of 3 new isolation centers in each senatorial district in the state, specifically in Ikare Akoko, Ondo Town, and Okitipupa, in addition to the Infectious Disease Hospital in Akure.

Only 7 functional ventilators statewide




Severe shortages of PPE, limited number of infrared thermometers & dire needs for ambulances for new centers

Funding Breakdown










